Pre-Employment Screening Program (PSP) Registration Now Available From FMCSA

Released on Friday, February 26, 2010

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (**FMCSA**) today launched the first phase of its **Driver Pre-Employment Screening Program (PSP)**. This program is intended to allow commercial motor carriers to electronically access **FMCSA** driver safety inspection and crash records as a part of the hiring process.

This first phase will provide motor carriers the opportunity to visit the PSP website and pre-register for the program by submitting their company contact information. The active program is expected to provide carrier access this summer.

In accordance with federal privacy laws, drivers must first give written consent in order for their records to be released to a prospective motor carrier-employer.
